

KOREAN HOMELAND EDUCATION



National Institute for International Education (NIIED)

is a national agency under the Ministry of Education established to educate overseas Koreans and promote international educational exchange and cooperation. It is responsible for planning, selecting, administering, and evaluating Korean Homeland Education.



Kongiu National University

is a university that fosters secondary school teachers. The university established the Institution of Korean Culture & Education, specializing in the education of overseas Koreans. The Institution operates domestic education programs (education, student guidance)

(A) What is Korean Homeland Education for overseas Koreans?

'Korean Homeland Education (K-HED)' is an educational program for overseas Koreans made to cultivate the ethnic identity of overseas Koreans and help next-generation overseas Koreans grow into global talents. This program comprises the Korean language, Korean culture, Korean history classes, global citizenship, and field learning.

K-HED is the only long-term educational program for overseas Koreans in the nation that provides career guidance and a network of overseas Koreans.

1. National Scholarships

Scholarship of the National Institute for International Education

National scholarship for K-HED students Recipient

Overseas Koreans who applied for the domestic education program for overseas Koreans and were recommended by a diplomatic office

Selection criteria

Reviewed and selected by the 'Scholarship Committee' based on intent, the potential for development, family background, and descendant of an independent patriot

Benefits

Full tuition fee for the program (one course) and 70% of the round-trip airfare

- * Airfare not included for Japan, China, Far East Russia (Maritime Province, Sakhalin, etc.), and Southeast Asian countries
- * Full tuition fee and airfare supported to descendants of an independent patriot

Number of beneficiaries

About 200 persons per year

- * The number of scholarship recipients of each course can be adjusted based on the scholarship application and selection status.
- Mational scholarship selection may be canceled if the recipient fails to complete the program or receives disciplinary action for violating campus rules.

 In this case, the recipient must return the scholarship.

Benefits for Students Completing Online Education

Benefits for those who completed online education

- O1 A certificate of completion is issued to those who satisfy the criteria for completing our online education.
- 02 If a student who completed online education applies for invitation education of the K-HED program for overseas Koreans, the student has priority when selecting national scholarship recipients.

2. Supporting Entrance to a Korean University (Graduate School)

- We provide a career counseling service to students who want to enter a Korean university or graduate school.
- University entrance presentations and support on university (graduate school) entrance process: We help fill out application documents, write a letter of self-introduction, and prepare for interviews based on admission type (overseas Koreans/foreigners).
- We support basic major course studies (support on basic major courses necessary to study at a university: math, sciences, etc.).
- Students can take general liberal arts lectures and participate in joint projects with mentors.
- We offer special lectures on career, major, and leadership.
- Students receive mentorship from senior students and take a tour around major university campuses in Korea.

* 44 students were admitted to a Korean university (graduate school) from 2018 to 2022 (including multiple acceptances).

3. Operation of Cooperation Universities



Benefits for entering a cooperation university

Benefits are granted such as credit recognition, completion recognition of Korean courses, overseas Korean scholarship, etc., to students who enter cooperation universities after completing K-HED (Invitation Education).



Credit Recognition

Completion of Korean Language, Korean History, Korean Culture, etc. from Korean Homeland Education is recognized as a credit at cooperation universities



Completion Recognition of Korean Courses

Completion of Korean Language classes from Korean Homeland Education is recognized as a credit for those students admitted via the Foreigner Students Exam


